Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Our theme this week is WONDER- This theme focuses on our ability to experience- the wonder of creation – the wonder of God's gifts to us- and the wonder of ourselves as gift to the world. Take some time this week to talk about these gifts and how it is appropriate to respond to them.

If you have been down to school, you may be aware of building work going on at the school. We have had two major projects being undertaken since the end of last term. The first is the structural upgrade to the Hinau block. This has been planned for some time and whilst it did take the structural engineers some time to develop a plan that would best meet the brief we are delighted it is finally underway. The upgrade means the installation of both concrete support structures at the ends and side of the building and reinforcing frames on the window side of the building. It will ensure much greater safety of the building.

The second project has been the development of an outdoor area for the Rata Whanau. This includes the installation of external doors, fencing and a wonderful deck. This area will be developed over the term and we are looking forward to watching our discoveryscape take shape. Thanks Mr Barrie Casley for the great job.

This area will have a wide range of activities available for your children to explore, play, engage with others and understand that learning is a life experience. It is not confined to books and paper or digital tools but rather it is the process of discovery and experimentation.
