Te Ao M**ā**ori

- the Māori Creation Theory
- Māui and other tūpuna bringing practical knowledge and resources to humans
- Māori exploration, discovery and migration
- Purposeful and functioning iwi settlements in Aotearoa as tangata whenua with some baseline Māori cultural value systems, knowledge and worldviews.

In order for our children to engage in this learning we would like to take them to the wonderful Te Ao Maori exhibitions at Te Papa.

Each whanay will visit Te papa as follows:

Monday - Totara Whanau Tuesday- Rata Whanau Wednesday- Hinau Whanau Thursday- Rimu Whanau
