How can we show Service in our classroom?

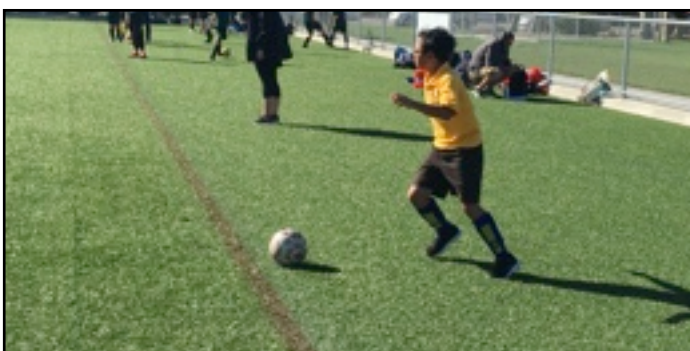
We can show service by offering people our time and being there for others when they are in need. eg) If you see someone who is struggling with their work, go up to them and help them.
